If the placement is called back to the medical facility, the regularly hourly base rate (task order) will be charged unless overtime is incurred (not inclusive of on-call time) due to the 40 hours already worked. Overtime rate is charged at the overtime rate for hours the placement worked. Vendor call back rates will apply once individual is physically on site and begins work.
